
Writer's Cup

As you are aware we are constantly looking to improve the safety and security of our school site.

We would like to remind **all our Parents & Carers** that the green gates to the main playground are now opened by a member of staff between the following times 11.40am-11.50am and 12.10pm-12.20pm for access to the Nursery.

Any parents or visitors who require access to the school or nursery outside of these times are requested to use the entrance on St Michaels Avenue and report to the school office.

In addition all children that are brought into school late or who are collected early will need to be accompanied to the school office where we would ask that they are signed in or out. They will then be taken to their class by a member of staff or if your child attends the Nursery you will be taken with your child to Carle class (Nursery).

Whilst we appreciate that these measures may cause some inconvenience we hope that you will all agree our priority is to keep all of the children in our care safe and secure.
