#### Dear families,

A big thank you to you for adhering to the school guidelines for drop off and collection. The atmosphere in school and on the school grounds remains very positive and it is important that we remain strict in following the risk assessment set out by the school to keep our children, staff and parents safe.

#### Please find detailed below a few gentle reminders:

- Please keep to your designated drop off and collection times. Please respect our neighbours and do not gather outside the gates early or park in front of their dates or drives.

- Mobile phones should not be used on school site.
- One adult only to accompany children onto site.
- After collection, please leave the playground promptly.
- Reading books are given out on Tuesdays and must only be returned on Fridays. This allows us to quarantine books for 72 hours.
- Please ensure we have up to date contact numbers should we need to contact you in an emergency or inform you of a class closure.
- Please ensure you have completed all consent forms for Tapestry (EYFS) and Seesaw (Key stage 1) to allow your child to access home learning and for you to view your child's learning journey at school.
